- On February 7th our KMS 7th graders traveled to the Grand Rapids Museum to visit The Body Reveals exhibit, students experienced hands on activities and wrote about their experiences.
- Winter assessments are complete, staff will look at student progress and areas of needed improvement to support learners now until the spring assessments.
- The MS has started a book study of the book Helping Billy, the group is made up of teachers, counselors and the principal, this book was written for educators on how to support students with trauma.

The Stop the Bleed program is a partnership between Munson and the Paradise Township EMS, Paradise Twp. EMS would train staff in bleed stop first aid and tourniquet application.

4. Request from Paradise Township - Dr. Keith Smith

Paradise Twp. is requesting that Kingsley Area Schools share the cost of a community police officer who is employed by the Grand Traverse County Sheriff's Department, the cost would be split between Paradise Twp., the Village of Kingsley, Mayfield Twp. and KAS, the proposed cost to KAS would be 18% = \$14,870.31.
